



Here are some suggestions to help taxpayers keep good records:



 In general, the IRS suggests that taxpayers keep records for three years from the date they filed the return. For business taxpayers, there's no particular method of bookkeeping they must use. 




confirm income and expenses. Taxpayers who have employees must keep all employment tax records for at least four years after the tax is due or paid, whichever is later.
